



Updated information 03.09.2020

Following on from return to school guidance here are some further updates to other aspects of the school day.

End of the day

Thank you to all parents working with the staggered end to the school day. Using the one way system means that families can get onto the yard safely and leave without crossing each other. Can we remind parents that only one adult plus other children are to come on site to keep the volume of people on the yard as low as possible. Also, as you walk on to the yard keep to the right of the cones (so nearest the infants) when you are waiting for your child/children so that adults collecting can get on to the yard and adults can maintain social distance from one another.

PE kits

PE kits can be brought to school from Monday 7th September. Please send your child or children in with their kit on a Monday. It will stay in school all week and then come home on a Friday.

Reading records and reading at home

During the coming weeks reading books will begin to be sent home for you to read with your child. We expect children to read 3 times over the week at home and children are rewarded if they keep this up with reading miles. Books given to children will have been quarantined then cleaned before they are put back on our shelves to be chosen.

Homework

At the moment our priorities for homework are reading, weekly spellings and using Sumdog and Rock Star Times Tables. Sumdog and Rock Star Times table require log-ins which pupils in Y4-6 already have. Y3 log-ins are currently being set up. We will resend log in cards home next week.

Parent Pay for Y3

We hope to have parent pay accounts set up by 07.09.2020 for our new Y3 pupils. Please look out for the email so that you can pay for your child's school lunch.

School Trips

At the moment we are not planning any school trips in light of current government guidance. As soon as this changes we will let you know. The Y6 residential has been postponed until the summer term and we will write to Y6 parents about this separately.

Swimming

There will be no school swimming until January at the earliest. We will update you as this advice changes.
