### Y3 and Geography

Year 3 have been looking at landmarks in Geography. We explored some different landmarks in the UK and then used the maps to find their location and record their grid references.

### Maths in Y4

Y4 pupils have been putting their problem solving skills to use in small groups by playing a variety of puzzle games. By working in this way pupils use their number knowledge, logical thinking and problem solving skills together.



### COVID update

If anyone in your household displays one of the following symptoms the whole household must isolate from day 1 whilst the person with the symptoms is waiting to be tested.

Symptoms are still:

- a high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

### What to do if you have symptoms

If you have any of the main symptoms of coronavirus:

1. Get a test to check if you have coronavirus as soon as possible.
2. Stay at home and do not have visitors until you get your test result – only leave your home to have a test.
3. Anyone you live with, and anyone in your support bubble, must also stay at home until you get your result.

You **MUST** inform school of suspected cases, contact through track and trace and genuine absence so that we can monitor the situation effectively.

If your child is absent for a reason linked to COVID such as a person with symptoms in their household they are not recorded as being ill on the register but as an absence linked to COVID.

Please follow this government guidance to protect all members of our school community.
